#### **ARCHERY IS BACK!**

We will resume our normal shoot schedule starting on June 3rd, with the following restrictions and guidelines in place:

- 1.) There will be no access to the archery building.
- 2.) Sign-up and fees will be accomplished at the window next to the archery pavilion.
- 3.) There will be no food or drinks sold at this time and until further notice.
- 4.) Groups are to be limited to 5 shooters.
- 5.) No sharing of Equipment.
- 6.) Social distancing of 6 ft is to be practiced while attending Wednesday shoots.
- 7.) Please follow any signage posted around the club since the porta-jons and archery pavilion have signage due to the current campground restrictions.

#### SHOOT TIMES & FEES

Registration and Shooting times 8 AM - 6 PM. No shooters allowed to start after 6:30 PM.

Members - \$10.00 Non-Members - \$12.00 Youth (13-17) & Cub (12 & Under) - FREE

#### **SCTP PRACTICE RESUMES!**

The following restrictions and guidelines are in place:

- 1.) When arriving at the club, participants must stay a minimum of 6 ft. apart when walking to the clubhouse.
- 2.) Participants may use tables on the porch of the clubhouse to set their gear, again observing 6 feet spacing.
- 3.) It is recommended that participants and family members bring their own chairs to sit in
- 4.) Two trap ranges will be used to avoid over-crowding.5.) The use of appointment times for rang-
- The use of appointment times for ranges will be implemented.
- 6.) During actual shooting, maintaining 6 foot spacing is easy to accomplish on the shooting range. The range can consist of 5 participants who will never shoot at a position that is closer than 6 feet.
  7.) Participants will not change their as-
- 7.) Participants will not change their assigned position or come in contact with the voice release speakers.
- 8.) Participants will not be permitted to share equipment.
- 9.) Participants and family members will not have access to the clubhouse except to use the restroom facilities. Restrooms will be sanitized at the end of the practice session.
- 10.) Participants must follow any additional signage posted at GCF&G.

### STEEL CHALLENGE LEAGUE SHOOTS RETURN!

To comply as much as possible with the orders from the governor we will be practicing social distancing as much as possible.

Anyone not currently shooting / ROing / or scoring will be asked to stay

in the grass, to maintain adequate distancing.

Spectators are asked to stay back by the tree line as much as possible. We will not be allowing anyone to share firearms / gear / ammunition / etc. unless in the same household until the order is lifted.

Pre-Registration on Practi-Score is highly recommended to aid in social distancing but not required.

GCF&G will not be providing water in water coolers anymore so please bring your own source of water or refreshments.

We will also not be painting targets inbetween every shooter to also aid in not having a bunch of people touch the same paint cans.

At the safety area please allow plenty of distance between you and other shooters. We will allow plenty of time for everyone to prepare and safely shoot.

We are also limiting the number of total shooters to <u>50</u> so we can maintain keeping less than 10 people per squad.
