ROOSTER RUN RECAP!

The 2nd Annual Rooster Run Youth Pheasant Hunt & Potluck Lunch is in the books and all went very well. Thirty-four young people became "Runners" on Saturday, November 13th. Some of our thirty-four young hunters returned for a second year, while others were first timers to the program.

Our Rooster Run Weekend began on Friday night with the 1st Annual "Kick-em Up" Kick-off Dinner. More than 100 Sponsors, VIP's, and Event Volunteers filled the clubhouse and enjoyed a Top Notch Pulled Pork, Beef Brisket & Chicken Dinner provided by our Friends at City Barbeque.

State Representative Bill Dean and State Senator Bob Hackett were on hand along with Scott Anger from the Greene County Sheriff's Office and Greene County Commissioner and GCF&G member Dick Gould. Also attending were Gail Matson from the Xenia FISH Food Pantry, Don Boling from Farmers & Hunters Feeding the Hungry, and Al Overholser from N.C.S.C. who video taped the event.

Sponsors were recognized and presented with a small token of our appreciation in the form of a laser engraved 32 OZ. 2021 Rooster Run Insulated Cooler from Bison Coolers in Fort worth, Texas. Four of last year's Rooster Run Event participants attended the dinner as Junior Ambassadors for this year's event. Elaina Moore, Nick Williams and Liam Wenning stole the spotlight as they spoke to the group about their favorite parts of the Rooster Run.

After Dinner Greene County Commissioner Dick Gould presented the club with a resolution designating Saturday, November 13th, 2021 as "Rooster Run Day" in Greene County. The resolution recognizes the many Conservation related projects and programs organized and implemented by our organization in Greene County, Ohio over the past 100 years.

Saturday morning dawned to partly cloudy skies, cool temperatures, and less than desirable winds. Twenty-three young hunters took to the fields, while eleven other hunters with less experience took their shots under watchful eyes, at launched birds. A total of nineteen birds were taken, and nine young hunters were able to harvest their first ever pheasant.

Following a cold and challenging, but safe morning afield, a group of more than 100 tired hunters and volunteers sat down to an extraordinary Potluck lunch. The centerpiece of that meal fit for a king was 150 pieces of Broasted Chicken compliments of Dot's Market in Kettering & Bellbrook. Several donated carry-in dishes made the outstanding meal complete.

After lunch, hunters who harvested their very first birds were recognized, and (4) \$25 Cabela's Gift Cards were handed out after the winning leg band numbers were drawn. Great "Swag Bags" and door prizes, each one an outdoor related item were given to every young hunter who participated.

Through hard work and dedication, the organization was able to make modest contributions in the name of GCF&G and the Rooster Run, to the numerous charitable programs who's logos appear below. A good time was had by all, and our outdoor legacy was once again shared with others...
