GATE CONTROLLER INSTALLATION UPDATE

As many of you may know we are installing a new Gate Controller beginning July 9th through July 17th. Since our current system is obsolete and un-supported, we were very vulnerable to losing our ability to keep the Gate locked if we had any power surge or lightening strike.

There will be two Card Readers on

the entrance and two Push to Exit Buttons on the exit. There are two different heights for the Card Readers and Push to Exit Buttons. The lower height set will be placed at a height for Cars and Pickup Trucks and the higher height will be for Commercial Trucks.

Upon exiting the Club you will now push a button to exit without having to use you card to exit. I know what you are going to say, someone could go over the fence and push the button and open the Gate. Well, that can't happen. The Push to Exit button will be tied into the loop sensor under the blacktop and if it does not sense a vehicle, it will not work.

All of our existing Gate Cards will work with the new system. However, I there are unconfirmed reports that there may be some older 128 bit Cards out there which will not work with this system. From the Range Chairman:

My goal from the beginning has been improving the safety of our Ranges and trying to educate shooters. Therefore, you will start to see additional signage on the Ranges to help everyone understand each of the restrictions we have had to add. I have confirmed with other members their interest in helping to make a Range Safety Video. Once completed, we will place a link on our website and YouTube Channel.

There have been mixed opinions about the "No Blue Sky" construction on the 7-Yard Handgun (Pistol) Range, but the addition of the Safety Ceiling and Baffle have proven effective. Almost one month after completion, we have had five (5) Baffle Strikes. Three (3) were 22 caliber and Two (2) were 9 mm. Since I have no record of what day these happened, it is very difficult to see what actually happened. Although I am disappointed that some members cannot control their Firearms in a proper manner, it tells me that these improvements were necessary and still required on all of the Handgun (Pistol) Ranges. Keep watching the Website and Facebook for the times and dates on the other Range upgrades.

I have one request from each Member that uses the Ranges. If you damage any part of the Range, no matter how insignificant you think it may be, please let me know. It would be better to let me know what and why it happened verses someone spending time looking at camera footage and tracking down the member. If you call the club phone (937) 372-8261 or email me at ranges@gcfng.com just leave or send a brief description of what happened and you wish to talk to me. Accidents do happen however, if you damage club property and you do not reported it, that is considered as intentional destruction of club property and cause for disciplinary action from the Board of Directors.
