At GCF&G we have 2 pistol leagues. The NRA league started April 13 and the NDR league started April 20. Both leagues use 22 caliber pistols. Both leagues have slow fire and rapid fire segments.

The NRA League is one handed shooting at 25 and 50-yards. In the NDR league you can use two hands and shoot at 15 and 25 yards.

Both leagues shoot on Thursday evening. The NDR league is held from 3:30 - 6:00.Each person shoots when a position is available. There is no need to stay the full 2.5 hours.

The NRA league forms up at 5:30 and shoots at 6:00 PM. Everyone shoots at the same time with range commands. The NDR match costs \$3.00 per night and the NRA \$10.00 per night.

There are awards at the end of the season for the top shooters. If you are interested in pistol shooting come out and give our leagues a try.

AS THE RANGES CHAIRMAN...

I WANT TO REVIEW SOME IMPORTANT RANGE SAFETY PRACTICES.

- When a cease fire is called, all magazines should be removed and all chambers cleared. The best option would be to have and use an empty chamber indicator.
- Gun should never be handled while someone is down range.
- All guns should point down range while on the benches.
- Ground Rules state that no long guns are to be used on the pistol ranges, including AR style pistols.
- ◆ Lastly and most importantly, you should NEVER point a gun at another person.
- There are video cameras on the ranges to help us enforce the rules. People who disregard these basic safety rules may be sanctioned or face expulsion from the club
- Please people, let's keep our club safe. Our survival depends on it!




