For you New Members. Last Year the Board a significant investment into a new Gate Controller and Card Readers. Be aware of your distance from the card readers and yellow safety bollards. Do Not run over the Bollards! They are plastic now but if there continues to be damage to the readers and Bollards, they will change to concrete or steel.

There are Cameras throughout the property, if you have any questions about our Video Security Policy, go to our website under General information/Policies and read the Video Security Policy.

If you are having issues with your Gate Card or looking for a second card, please go to the website.

Ranges (Mike Given)

The Winter weather has given us a few great shooting days and the Ranges have been very busy. The walk to the Ranges are still very muddy so be very careful. We still have gravel and dirt to move to bring everything back the way it was before our construction improvements on the 7 and 25-yard pistol bays. All Ranges will be closed during cleanup weekend April 9th and 10th.

Scheduled Maintenance and Improvements have been scheduled for Cleanup Weekend!

We will need Members on Clean up Weekend that can help with the construction of a Safety Ceiling and down Range Baffle at the 7-Yard Pistol Bay. We will have to have good weather forecasted for both days before construction begins. Once construction begins, that Range will be closed until completion. I believe we can get the 7-Yard Pistol completed in those two days.

There is a lot of worked need at the Club and not just the Ranges. Please check with Kenny Mitch on how you may help out on Cleanup Weekend. As I mentioned in last month's Newsletter, there have been reports of unsafe acts on both Rifle and Pistol Bays. This includes shooting centerfire Rifles/Shotguns on the Pistol Bays and running with a loaded Rifle while behind the firing line. As a general statement, Firearm Safety on the Ranges needs major improvement.

Each person using the ranges is required to read and follow these rules. There are even some good YouTube videos showing Indoor and Outdoor Range Safety and Range Etiquette including the one published by ODNR for the Spring Valley Shooting Range, NRA and Smith and Wesson, please take some time and watch a few of these.

These Safety Rules are not mere suggestions; ignoring the rules is cause for corrective action including losing your membership. If you bring a guest, you are also responsible for their actions.

If your new to shooting or do not have much Firearm/Range experience, please reach out to me. I would be happy to schedule some time with you or if there is enough interest from others, we can make a day of it.

I'm sure I could get enough Range Officers to help me out. My number one objective as Range Chairman is safety; this cannot be compromised or ignored. We do not pay for the Ranges to be patrolled 100% of the time, it is your club and we do rely on the membership to help keeping it safe. ranges@gcfng.com.


